Reading

Reading is the **KEY** to learning

Story time: This term, the children will be looking at traditional tales, fairy stories, and adventure stories.



In **Term 1**, your child will be completing a project based unit of work called "Superheroes!". In **English**, they will look at adventure stories and retell a story in their own words. In **History** they will look at real life heroes and how they help people, and how toys have changed throughout history. In **Science**, your child will look at the human body and the amazing things it can do!

In **Term 2**, your child will focus on the Christmas story. In English they will look at different ways of telling a story, and use their speaking and listening skills to rehearse their Nativity play.

Maths: Number and place value, addition and subtraction, number patterns, measurement, and shape.

RE: Christianity—why did Jesus tell stories? The Nativity.

PE: Dance and team games.

Computing: E-Safety, and stop motion animation.
