This term's curriculum topics

'Do you want to be friends?' & 'Festivals'

Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

We will be talking about making new friends, being kind and helpful. We will be talking about people who help us at home and in school. We will be learning about different emotions and how our actions may affect how others feel. Learning the class routine and talking about why we need rules such as: sharing, walking inside school, looking after things and being independent.

Communication and Language; Literacy (CL)(L)

We will be learning letter sounds. We will be using a combination of Read Write Inc and Jolly Phonics. We will also be listening and joining in with stories, rhymes and songs and children will be learning to write their name.

Maths (M)

Reciting number names in sequence (1-10) forwards and backwards, counting and identifying numbers and 2D shapes.

Understanding the World (UW)

Learning about the world in which we live, starting with home, our classroom, the school and the outside environment. We will be learning about seasons and will go for learning walks outside.

Physical Development (PD)

Naming basic body parts by singing 'Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes' and other songs. Using the outside area to improve and refine motor skills.

Expressive Arts and Design (EA&D)

We will be doing self portraits and collages. We will be joining in with favourite songs and rhymes, painting and drawing. Exploring our surroundings indoors and outdoors using our five senses. We will be learning about different festivals and celebrations that happen in the world.
