A Happy New Year to all children and families.



Please ensure that all items of clothing is named and that spare items of clothing is packed in your child's bag. Children must be wearing the correct uniform. The children in Reception will start forest school in the next few weeks. Letters will be sent home. Please ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for their outdoor learning.



When collecting children, please ensure that you are not using your mobile phones for safety reasons .



This term, your child will be learning about the following in their subjects:

English: Stories, role play, writing names and CVC words. Writing the alphabet and lower case letters.

Phonics: The children in nursery will learn one sound a week, and reception children will learn several sounds a week.

Maths: Counting, number recognition to 20, 2D shapes, sizes, ordering numbers to 20. Number bonds to 10, and finding more or less.

Science: looking at the environment and at winter and ice.

RE: Celebrations and festivals and the Easter story.

Art: Artwork based on topic, seasons and festivals, castles and dragons, minibests.

Music: learning nursery rhymes and festival songs.

PSHE: Rights respecting school, British Values, Going for Goals, Say no to Bullying, class rules, behaviour expectations, keeping healthy.

Educational Visit: Local visit to park, local area.

In nursery, library book day is Thursday. Please return reading folders by Wednesday so that they can be changed.


In reception Library day is Friday. Please return book folders by Thursday
