This term, your child will be learning about the following in their subjects:

English: fiction and non fiction - including the different features of non fiction texts, recounts, letter writing, and stories in familiar settings

Maths: Place value, four operations, problem solving, measurement, and properties of shape

Science: Growth and survival, seasonal changes

RE: Christianity, with a focus on the stories that Jesus told, and the Christmas Story in Term 2

PE including 'Mile a day': games, circuit training

Computing: Online safety, mouse control

Art: Exploring colour and the works of Mondrian

Music: Rhythm patterns and singing

Geography: The UK, and the continents of the world

French: Numbers and colours

PHSE: Rights respecting school, British Values, "going for goals"

Educational Visits: Local area walk
