English: fiction and non fiction - including the different features of non fiction texts, recounts, letter writing, and adventure stories.

Maths: Place value, four operations, problem solving, measurement, and properties of shape

Science: everyday materials, super scientists

RE: different special books, Easter

PE including 'Mile a day': gymnastics, dance

Computing: using different software to create text and images, programming

Art: light and dark colours, including silhouettes, different types of patterns, including on flags.

Music: rhythm patterns and singing

Geography: Famous explorers and map skills

History: Great Fire of London

PSHE: Rights respecting school, British Values, "going for goals", "say no to bullying"
