English: fiction and non fiction, poems, explanation writing including reports and extending writing.

Science: Adaptation and Inheritance, Materials, Earth and Space and Seeing light.

RE: What do other religions tell us about God?

PE including 'Mile a day': rounders, rugby and swimming

Computing: Online safety, Scratch—animation

Art and DT: Frozen Planet - Building Igloos

Music: learning to play the Guitar

History: The Victorians

Geography: The Mountain Environment

French: All about me, games and songs

PHSE: Rights respecting school, British Values
