Children should bring a named water bottle. They may bring a piece of fruit from home.

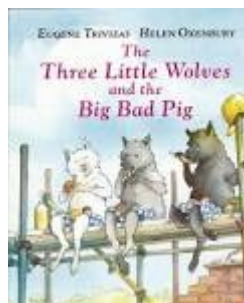


Reading

English: Traditional tales and non-fiction writing linked to the Great Fire of London.

Maths: Number and place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, measurement, and statistics.

Science: Growth and survival, and habitats.

RE: Belonging to Christianity, and Christmas.

PE: Games and circuit training.

Computing: E-Safety, programming and computer games.

Art: Warm and cold colours, oil pastels and painting based on the Great Fire of London.

Music: Singing with a visiting music specialist.
