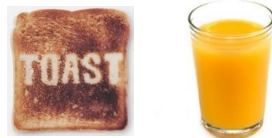

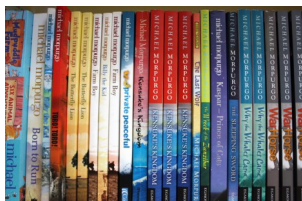

This term's curriculum topics

Year 6

English: Biographies, autobiographies, poetry, instructions and grammar and extended writing.

Maths: Number patterns, decimal notation, position decimal numbers, partitioning, algebra, fractions, data handling, percentages and working on their reasoning skills to solve problems



Science: Healthy bodies and seeing light.

Computing: We are app planners (planning the creation of a mobile app).

Geography: Physical geography – including lines of latitude and longitude, biomes, vegetation belts, rivers, mountains, volcanoes and earthquakes
