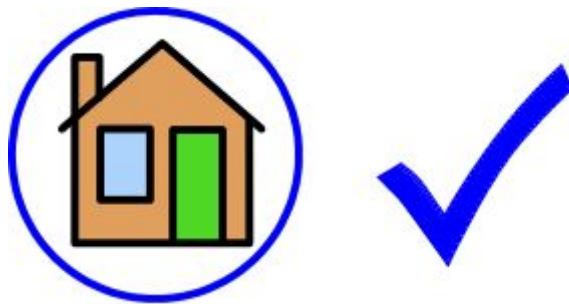


Returning to School

You will be in a group of children at nursery. Some of your friends will be there, but there will be some new children too. You might not see all of your friends when you come back to nursery.

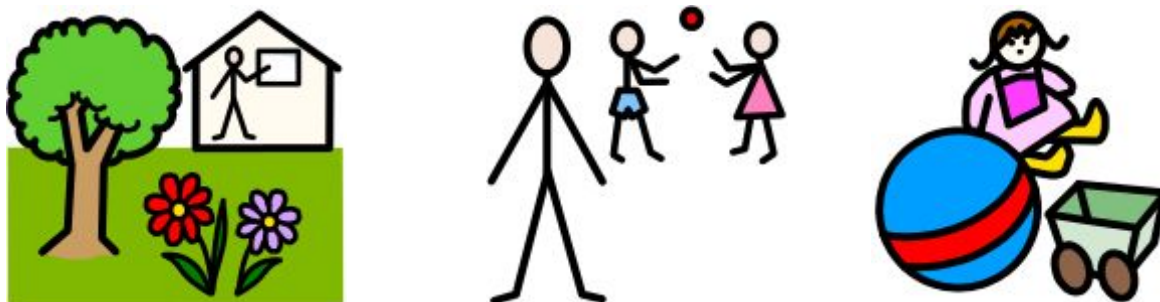


Nursery will look a little bit different. The walls have been painted different colours.

Everyone will be washing their hands very regularly, with soap and water, for at least 20 seconds.



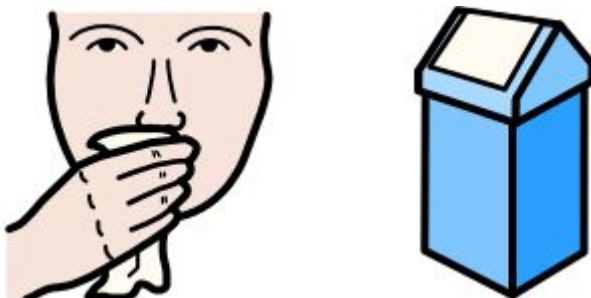

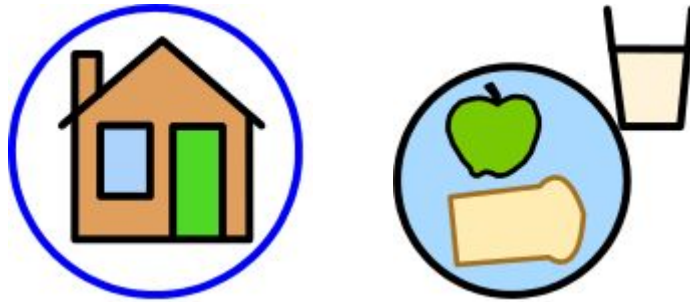
“Wash, wash, wash your hands, make them nice and clean.

Wash the front, and wash the back, and the fingers in between.”

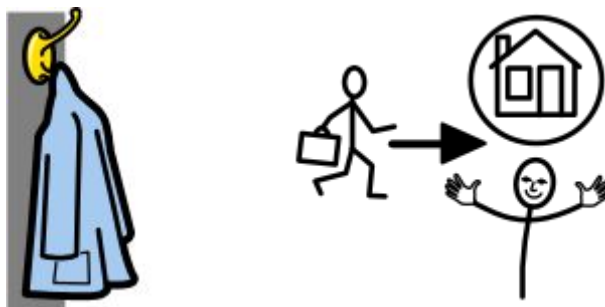
Remember to use a tissue if you cough or sneeze. You need to try and remember to put your own tissue in the bin when you have finished with it.
