


Returning to School


Since 23rd March, school has been closed to most children.



You have stayed at home, doing some fun learning activities. Staying at home might have been a bit boring, but it was the right thing to do!



Home learning and learning at school are different. At home, you might have done some work on the computer, or in a workbook.



The government have now decided that it is safe for some children to return to school.



The school and your family will help you to get ready for returning.

You will come to school through the normal gate, but you might come to school a little bit later than normal.



You need to say goodbye to whoever brings you to school at the gate, and then come into the playground by yourself.



When you are in the playground, you won't be able to go straight to your classroom. You will have to line up in the playground first. There will be teachers there to help you, and show you what to do. You will need to line up with lots of space between you and your friends.



You will need to wash your hands with soap and water, for at least 20 seconds, before you can come into school. There is a special new sink outside that you can use!




You will be in a group of children from your year group called a 'bubble'. These groups will be small to keep you safe but you might not be with all of your friends from your class before lockdown.



Your teacher may be a different teacher than usual, but they will be supportive and help you with your learning. Lots of fun activities have been planned.



You will have your own desk to sit at with your own set of resources to use. Your teacher will tell you where to sit.



You might be in your classroom, or a different KS1 classroom. It will look a little bit different - some things have been moved so that you can keep a safe distance from others.



You will have an area to play in, but you need to try and stay 2m away from your friends whenever you can.




You will have lunch in your classroom bubble. Lunch will be made by the school, you cannot bring a packed lunch in with you. It will be delivered to the classroom - you don't need to carry it through the school.




Everyone will be washing their hands very regularly, with soap and water, for at least 20 seconds.



Remember to use a tissue if you cough or sneeze. You need to put your own tissue in the bin when you have finished with it.



At the end of the day, you will line up in the playground. You need to wait until your teacher tells you that you can go home. An adult will collect you from the playground.
