Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 have learning online throughout the day. Therefore, it is essential each child can access a device, preferably a Chromebook or laptop, to enable them to take full advantage of the teaching and learning we are offering.

Year 1 & 2 have a mixture of teaching being offered online and through packs which need to be collected as soon as possible from school. These children need access to a phone or tablet (even better if it is a Chromebook or laptop). We have a limited number of data hubs and data SIMS for families in need.

EYFS children have learning packs to be collected from school as well as storytime phonics online. You can use smartphones and tablets for this as well as access through google classroom.

Teachers have prepared a full timetable of learning which children are expected to complete - contact us for support if needed.

If your child does not have a space to learn at home and/or does not engage with home learning, the government guidance classifies them as vulnerable and says they should be in school. We are monitoring the children's engagement and will do our best to support you so they can learn at home. However, if it is clear they are unable to work at home and are vulnerable, we will be in touch to discuss your child coming into school so their education is not disrupted.

We hope we can work together so all our children can continue to learn, be kept safe and have a bright future ahead of them.
