R.E. - What kind of world did Jesus want? Understand and use Bible references

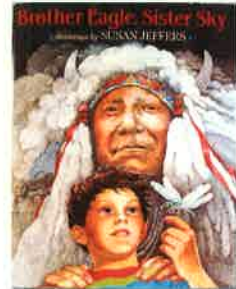
Computing - To create a clicker game using Scratch

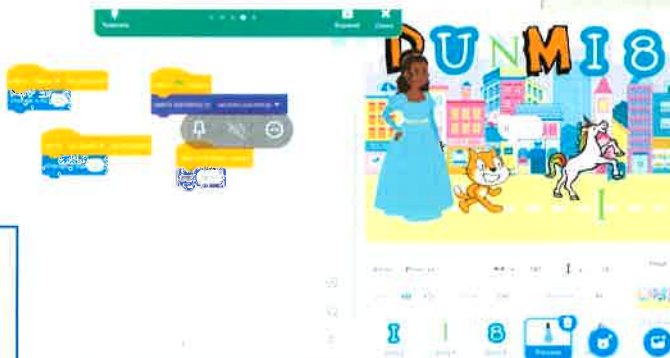
