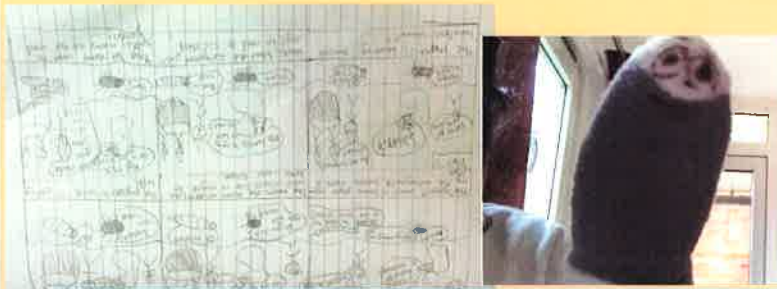

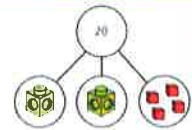
Dear diary
