Communication and Language

LO: I can talk about the kind of pet that I would like and if it would fit in with my lifestyle.

In the book 'Dear Zoo' the child was sent several pets which were not appropriate for them.

Children to think about a pet they would like and would it fit in with their lifestyle.

What would make a good pet?

Personal, Social, and Emotional Development

LO: I know how to look after my teeth.

We will find out about good oral health, and why it is important to brush our teeth carefully.

What happens when we brush our teeth?

Understanding the World

LO: To know what a map is for.

We will look at different maps, and find out how to follow a simple map route. We will make our own maps to help guide people around the EYFS area.

Can you find our classroom on the map?

Mathematics

LO: I can give clear directions using specific language.

We will practise following instructions and then give clear instructions to our friends to navigate them to a destination. .

Which direction should we go in?

Physical Development

LO: I can find my own space to be in.

We will practise finding and staying in our own space whilst following a fixed route.

Can you follow a map without touching anything that comes in your way?

Expressive Arts and Design

LO: I can design a bed for a pet.

The children will design a bed for a pet of their choice. They will think about which materials they can use, and how to joined it all together.

What size bed will your pet need?

The children will research facts about different pets and create their own fact file.
