Reception children spend a long period of time learning outside so don't forget to apply sunscreen before school each day.





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Communication and Language

LO: I can talk about what I need to do to make sure my pet is happy.

The children will think and talk about what they need to do to keep a pet happy and safe.

Can you tell someone one thing you need to do to keep an animal happy and safe?

Personal, Social, and Emotional Development

LO: I can talk about ways to keep myself and a pet healthy.

We are going to be looking at the similarities and differences when keeping animals and humans healthy.

What do animals and humans need to grow and stay strong?

Understanding the World

LO: I can investigate where different animals live.

The children will look at where different animals live how their habitats are similar/different.

Can you think of any animals that do not live in this country?

Mathematics

LO: I can recognise 3D shapes.

The children will look at 3D shapes and use mathematical language to describe them.

Can you tell someone about shapes you have learnt about?

Physical Development

LO: I can balance an egg on a spoon.

The children are practising walking with an egg balanced on a spoon ready for Sports Day.

Can you walk between the cones without the egg falling off the spoon?

Expressive Arts and Design

LO: I can use pencils to sketch an animal.

The children will use colouring pencils to draw a picture of a pet they either have or would like.

How do you hold your pencil?

Literacy

LO: I can write an adventure story.

The children are going to be learning all about dogs this week. They are going to write an exciting story about all the adventures a dog could have.
