English

This week we are continuing to the text 'Olga da Polga'. Children have enjoyed creating a character description and sequencing the story. As part of our grammar focus we have learned about nouns and adjectives.

Maths

This week in maths we have continued to learn our number bonds using number lines, ten frames and part-whole models to support us. We have weekly tests to see how children are getting on. Please continue to support your child's fluency by using Education City, Hit the Button and encouraging them to recall the number facts regularly.

Childhood

Our wider curriculum this term focuses on childhood, and how it has changed from the past to present day.



This knowledge-rich project teaches children about everyday life and families today, including comparisons with childhood in the 1950s, using artefacts and a range of different sources.

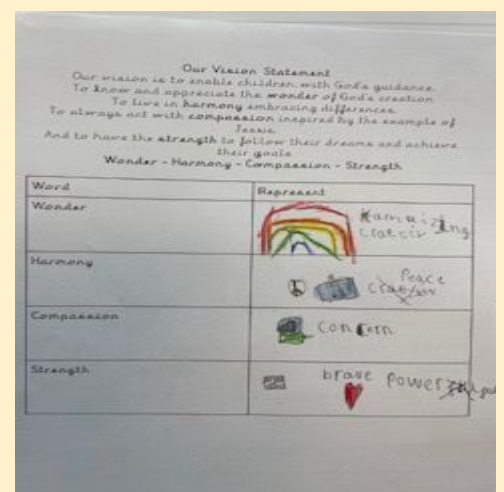
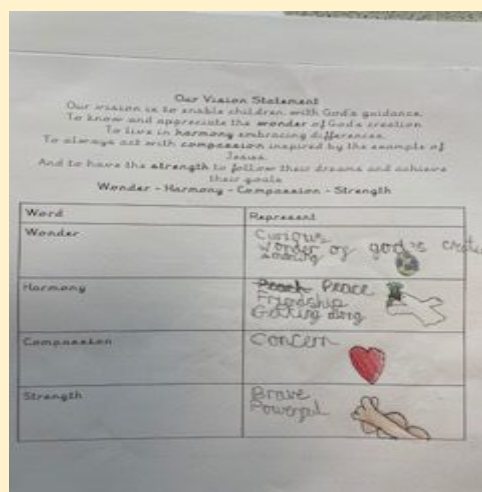
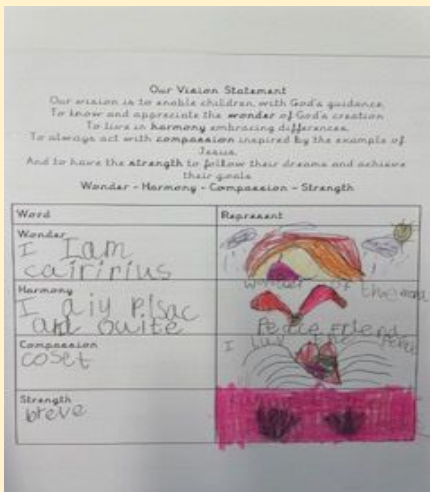
