Last week, we welcomed our new reception children's parents into school for a guided tour and to share information about starting school in September. Some of the children were very reluctant to leave after - they enjoyed it so much!

We were able to share the new light grey sweatshirt with our new parents. We currently have this on display in our new reception area. It will be introduced for nursery and reception children only in September (keeping any red sweatshirts for P.E.).



Children in year 1 to 6 will continue to wear the red sweatshirt next academic year, with proposals to introduce the grey sweatshirt to the whole school in September 2023. Red sweatshirts would be used for outdoor P.E. and sport competitions. We will also hold a parent forum to consult, discuss and explain the reasoning behind these changes.

In English the children have been introduced to our new book "The Storm Whale'. The children have designed a title page and have also written a diary entry in the character of


