Winter bugs are causing some absence

Unfortunately, as children have grouped together again after being separated during the holiday, winter bugs are hitting us hard particularly in KS1. This week many children and adults have been poorly with a vomiting bug. This is usual for this time of year and if your child is well, it is really important they come into school. Children can return to school 48 hours after the last time they vomited/had diarrhea.

Punctuality - please help by getting children to school on time

Lessons start promptly after the gates close at 8:45am with phonics, handwriting, maths fluency, spellings, etc.

Children arriving late cause unnecessary extra workload for staff and and disrupt the learning of other children as they enter. It causes anxiety for the children who are late and means they are missing essential learning.
